And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another - and all the more as you see the Day approaching. - Hebrews 10:24-25

The Concept of Membership is Biblical

Though the term itself isn't mentioned in the Bible, believers throughout the New Testament clearly identified themselves with a specific local body.

Membership is Valuable to Church Leadership

The leadership of the church is able to best care for those in the church when they know the people of their church.

Membership Benefits the Individual

Membership challenges us to grow beyond good intentions and into committed participation.

WHAT DOES A CHURCH MEMBER LOOK LIKE?

A member's life shows the evidence of devotion to both Christ and His Church. Though no one can claim to show these things perfectly, here are the marks of a participating member:

GRACE

Ephesians 2:8-9

surrendering self-righteousness, fully trusting that Christ's death on the cross paid for sin's penalty in full

GROWTH

2 Peter 3:18

continual evidence of a changing life and pursuit of Christ-likeness

GROUPS

Acts 2:46

connection with others in significant relationships through small groups

GIFTS

Romans 12:6-8

serving Christ's body according to each individual's spiritual giftedness and possessions

GOOD STEWARDSHIP

1 Peter 4:10

honoring God with one's resources of time, talent, and treasures

WHAT ICC BELIEVES



We believe there is one God, eternally existing in three persons known as the Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

God created humans to be in fellowship with Him, but humanity's choice to follow their own path outside of God's will has separated us from Him. We need God's saving grace - not human effort - to bring us back into fellowship with Him. This salvation can only be received by repentance and faith.







Jesus Christ, the second person of the Trinity, lived a perfectly sinless life on earth. He took on the consequences of our rebellion by dying on a cross so that he could give us a way to return to fellowship with God. He rose from the dead to be the one and only Mediator between God and us, and He will one day return to earth.

The Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity, permanently indwells and equips believers for personal growth and service in the church.





The church's role is to glorify God and serve others in His name. At the end, all will be judged, and those who have received forgiveness through Christ will enjoy eternal fellowship with God.
